Hi Tim,

Thank you for inviting me to the Exec meeting. I attach a copy of the slides from Monday, with modifications, as we discussed. For complete clarity please can confirm some points:

1. Julia and I will set up a Committee with the listed members in Slide 19.
2. I have been thinking about the name of the body and believe it would **not** be in the interest of the Profession to include the word "Improvement". There is so much orchestrated news in the media about the "failing" NHS that using this word could be seen to imply our Speciality is under-performing and needs "improving" to a reasonable standard. Are you happy with the alternative **BOA Quality Orthopaedic Outcomes Committee (QOC)**. The word "quality" has no such connotation of a starting position of underperformance - indeed quite the opposite!

We have agreed to meet to prioritise the items to scope as soon as Julia is in post . We will meet with the FOI office and HQIP to gain some answers before calling an early meeting of the whole Committee.
